What To Do before and after your Garden Route tour We can assist with the following arrangements and bookings: Cape Point with Hiking & Biking

This is a full Cape Peninsula tour. We follow the Atlantic coast past Clifton, Camps Bay & Llandudno, to the fishing village at Hout Bay. Here you have the option of doing a 1/2-hour scenic boat ride to visit an impressive seal colony (R35). Then it's on over Chapman's Peak Drive, to the Cape Of Good Hope Nature Reserve. We take mountain bikes along for those who wish to get out of the bus and smell the sea air and the many flowers. You can cycle as much or as little as you like, as the support van is always nearby. For real fresh air fiends there is also a 1/2-hour cliff top hike from Cape Point to the Cape of Good Hope. We have a picnic lunch somewhere in the reserve (on a sunny day take along a bathing suit) and return home via a rare colony of Jackass penguins at Boulders Beach on the Indian Ocean (own account)

This is a truly mellow day spent absorbing the rich beauty and history of the greater Cape Wine lands – we visit Stellenbosch, Paarl and Franschoek, with a cellar tour in one, and tastings in each region. Enjoy spectacular views during a sumptuous picnic lunch – by the time you return you should be feeling pretty rosy!

As above, but with the addition of some cycling amongst the vineyards – nothing too taxing, just enough to get a little exercise and make you even more thirsty!
